Minutes for November 3, 2019 Annual Meeting

President's Report:

- 1) Status of officers: Current HRPC members are as noted in the header. This is an election year. Current officers are running.
- 2) Member summary: The Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club had 222 active members when we met for the 2018 Annual Meeting. 35 members from 2018 did not renew for 2019. We currently have 187 active members; an overall decrease of 15.8.
- 3) AGC officers: Current AGC officers are: President: Tom D Asto, Vice President: Michael Burke, Executive Vice President: Andrew Pelton, Secretary: Katherine Harrison, Treasurer: Cherie Sanders

Vice President Report: Nothing to report

Secretary-Treasurer Report:

- 1) Balance of Checking Account: Start of fiscal: \$14,549.26, End:\$15,062.04 Increase of \$512.78. **Action item:** Officers asked to see if M&T offers no fee checking for 501C3 organization.
- 2) Certificate of Deposits: Funds in new 12 month CD at rate of 0.10%. Matures on 6/25/2019. Current balance \$6,315.29, an increase of \$6.32 from last year. **Action item:** Officers asked to look into Marcus Goldman Sachs High Yield Certificate of Deposit for possible higher interest rate. **Follow-up:** As of writing MGS is offering 2.10% interest for a one year CD. Appears to be a viable option when our current M&T CD matures in June. Need to do more investigation to see how the terms apply to a 501c7 organization.
- 3) Financial records: Submitted in writing. Receipts and details available for review. Treasurer's report approved as submitted.
- 4) Tax Status: Forms were submitted for 2018. Will be working on this year (2019) taxes soon.
- 5) Electronic payments. M&T electronic payment via Payeezy is working. Call Dale at 410-530-5537 to process a credit card. **Action Item:** Working to get web page set up to accept credit payment. Most fees are waived due to our limited Business transaction within our club. Annual fee is \$120 for Payeeze web software, fees are 3-3.5% plus \$0.10 flat transaction fee. There was a one-time \$75 web setup fee. **Action Item:** Need to call M&T. It looks like M&T are charging a fee for an IRS Name/id discrepancy. **Follow-up:** M&T was called. The IRS Name/id discrepancy note was in error. The note should have read that the \$9.99 was a reduced M&T fee (normally \$15) for the credit card service.
- 6) Meeting Minutes: Minutes from 2018 Annual Meeting approved as written.

Old Business:

- 1) Storage: No updates.
- 2) Apparel: Inventory is good. Prices: Hats \$10, Tees are \$10 for sizes S through XL, \$12 for XXL & XXXL. \$2.00 Patches & Window clings. \$0.50 HRPC ECI (standard or rim-fire). Polo shirts (black) are \$18 for S through XL and \$20 for XXL. No action needed.
- 3) Web Hosting: Link to update web page is going to old service. **Action item.** Need to contact Yahoo Small Business to resolve. **Follow-up:** Link has been corrected. Documents have been updated.
- 4) CMP: Homewood Rifle and Pistol Club renewed as a Civilian Marksmanship Program affiliate. This satisfies one of the requirements for individuals wanting to purchase firearms through the CMP. Full eligibility requirements can be found at <http://www.thecmp.org/eligibility.htm>
- 5) Club Trap/rifle Shoots: Had good food from Mission Barbecue for summer shoots. Summer rifle shoot had low attendance. We moved it to Saturday October 3rd for 2020 hoping there will be better attendance with cooler weather.
- 6) Family rate: Family annual dues are 50% of the regular member annual dues. The rate will apply to spouses, children, parents, grandchildren and grandparents of a current primary club member. Rate to continue for 2020.
- 7) New members: Initiation fee is \$10 for all new members. New member received a patch, window cling and four ECI's at the range orientation for the 2019 season. Rate to continue for 2020.
- 8) Scout Shoots: HRPC hosted shoots for Troop 75 and Troop 737.
- 9) Shooting Steel: AGC is working on discrepancy between Range Rules and Policy and Procedure. Rules specify "Magum Rifle", while P&P excludes "rifle".
- 10) Never Forget Garden: HRPC is working with AGC and other clubs to establish a memorial garden to commemorate the 100 anniversary of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Biggest issue will be the maintenance.

New Business:

- 1) Annual Meeting Date: Motion to change the day of the meeting to Saturday. Motion failed.
- 2) Club License plates: Member asked if HRPC would want to club license plates. Follow-up. The inquiring member researched and found the following information for "vanity plate" on the MVA website. The club would need at least 25 people willing to purchase for the tags - and be able to send in their names with the application. There are also specifics on color of the logo, and a host of other items. The general thought is the club will not have enough interest based on the general response at the meeting. If you would be interested in a HRPC license plate please contact the HRPC officers.
